STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Information Provided to Veterans by the Bureau of Vital Statistics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 2706, sub-§ 6 is enacted to read:

6. Records furnished to veterans without charge. Notwithstanding any provision of this Title or Title 30, or any regulation promulgated under this Title, copies of certificates or records shall be issued without charge to any veteran, as defined in Title 37, or any spouse or dependent of a veteran, if the person requesting the copies provides the issuing agent with adequate proof that he is a veteran of the spouse or dependent of a veteran.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that copies of records compiled by the Bureau of Vital Statistics shall be furnished free of charge to veterans and their spouses and dependents.
