STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require a Permit for Purse Seining on the Medomak River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 6572 is enacted to read:

§ 6572. Medomak River

It is unlawful to use a purse seine within the waters of the Medomak River; except that the commissioner may, upon application and subject to regulations promulgated by the commissioner, issue permits for the use of purse seines in that river.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the use of purse seines in the Medomak River. Purse seines would only be allowed by permit issued by the Commissioner of Marine Resources.
