STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide Equitable Treatment for Elderly Maine Residents Serviced by New Hampshire Electric Utilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 102, as amended by PL 1979, c. 368, is further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read:

Any public utility, providing service within the State, which offers a discount to any of its customers who fall within a specifically designated class shall offer that discount to every person it serves who falls within that class. For purposes of this section, the creation of a class based on the age of persons within that class is permissible.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently a New Hampshire electric utility offers a rate discount to elderly New Hampshire residents, but does not offer the same discount to elderly Maine residents served by that utility. This bill would require a utility providing service in this State to extend any discount it offers, to every person it serves who falls within the class of persons offered the discount.
