Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out the last
3 lines and inserting in their place the following:
'Any balance remaining ~~shall continue from year to year as a
fund available~~ may be allocated by the Legislature on the recom-
mendation of the legislative committee having jurisdiction over
natural resources for the purposes set out in this section and for
no other purpose.'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out the
last 4 lines and inserting in their place the following:
'The Director of the Bureau of Public Lands may use such revenues

set forth in section 4162. These revenues shall be administered


