**AN ACT to appropriate \$2,500 to the Sanford Parks and Recreation Department to Host the 1981 New England Babe Ruth Baseball Tournament.**

---

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Sanford Parks and Recreation Department will host the New England Babe Ruth Baseball Tournament in August 1981; and

Whereas, Sanford was chosen for this honor over several other New England communities; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Act to appropriate \$2,500 to help enable the town of Sanford to defray the costs of hosting the tournament; and

Whereas, the appropriation must be made before August 1981, a date which will fall before the normal effective date of nonemergency Acts passed at the first regular session of the 110th Legislature; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sanford Parks and Recreation Department; appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sanford Parks and Recreation Department the sum of \$2,500 to be used to defray expenses incurred in hosting the 1981 New England Babe Ruth Baseball Tournament.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$2,500 to the Sanford Parks and Recreation Department which will host the New England Babe Ruth Baseball Tournament in August 1981.
