COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 169, L.D. 222, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Additional Polling Places in Municipalities with Large Fluctuations in Voter Turnout."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'21 MRSA §1572, sub-§1, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 782, §16, is further amended by adding before the last sentence a new sentence to read:

Voting districts may be established or consolidated under this section for all or only certain classes of elections.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit municipal officials, after notice and public hearing, to establish additional voting districts or consolidate existing voting districts for some or all types of elections.
