STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Designate Certain Parts of Routes 17 and 4 as Scenic Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Designation of Scenic Highway. Resolved: That the portion of Route 17 between Mexico and Oquossoc and the portion of Route 4 between Oquossoc and Rangeley be designated as a scenic highway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to designate the part of Route 17 between Mexico and Oquossoc and the part of Route 4 between Oquossoc and Rangeley as scenic highway.
