COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 217, L.D. 254, Bill,
"AN ACT to Prohibit Taking Antlerless Deer in Certain
Municipalities and Townships."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7457, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Taking of antlerless deer only. Notwithstanding sub-
section 1, the commissioner may regulate the number of each
sex of deer taken in any part of the state.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment authorizes the Commissioner
← of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to establish
areas where only antlered deer may be hunted.
