HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.222, L.D. 259, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Lien Law for Sewer Districts."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

38 MRSA §1208, 2nd ¶, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §389, is further amended by adding after the 4th sentence a new sentence to read:

The notice shall contain a statement that the district is willing to arrange installment payments of the outstanding debt.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for a notice to be given to a person who has failed to pay the sewer rate that the sanitary district is willing to arrange an installment payment for the outstanding debt.
