HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 224, L.D. 261, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Maine Set-aside Program under the State Purchasing Law to Expand Work Opportunities for Multiple Handicapped Citizens."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'E. The total value of contracts awarded under the authority of this subsection shall not exceed \$500,000 in the 1981-82 fiscal year, and \$1,000,000 in the 1982-83 fiscal year and thereafter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the expenditure that may be made under this law. The maximum cost possible to the State, of the bill, with the amendment will be \$25,000 for the 1981-82 fiscal year, and \$50,000 for the 1982-83 fiscal year and thereafter. It is unlikely that either of these limits could be reached.
