SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 232,
L.D. 269, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Interagency Licensing of
Residential Facilities and Programs for Children."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the title the follow-
ing:

'Amend the Bill in section 3, in the ^{3rd} and ^{4th} lines (3rd in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined word and figure "subsection 2" and
inserting in their place the underlined word and figure 'subsection
4'

Further amend the Bill in section 4, in that part designated
"§8101.", subsection 1, paragraph C, in the last line, (same in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined word and figure "subsection 2"
and inserting in their place the underlined word and figure 'sub-
section 4'

Further amend the Amendment in the first paragraph/by striking
out in the first line the word "Amend" and inserting in its place
the words 'Further amend'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting after the first
paragraph after the title the following:

'Further ^{amend} the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§8101."
subsection 4, in the 3rd sentence by striking out the underlined
words "may include" and inserting in their place the underlined
word 'includes'

This amendment makes technical changes in the numbering of subsections and ensures the inclusion of all types of facilities listed in Title 22, section 8101, subsection 4, in the definition of residential child care facility.
