COMMITTEE AMENDMENT A"to H.P. 232, L.D. 269, Bill, "AN ACT to Require Interagency Licensing of Residential Facilities and Programs for Children."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§8101." subsection 4, 4th line (3rd line in LD) by striking out the underlined word "shall" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'does'

Further amend the bill in section 4, in that part designated "§8102." subsection 1, by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following: 'The department shall adopt rules for children's homes in conformity with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375.'

Further amend the bill in section 4, in that part designated (first line in L.D.)

"§8105." subsection 1, 2nd line,/by striking out the underlined word "Act" and inserting in its place the underlined word:

'section'

Further amend the bill in section 4, in that part designated "§8105." subsection 2, 2nd line (same in LD) by striking out the underlined word "Act" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'section'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Scc. 6. 22 MRSA §8106 is enacted to read:

§8106. Report

The Commissioner of Human Services shall prepare a progress report on the operation of this chapter and make this report available to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional Services by March 1, 1982. The commissioner shall make a further report to the same committee by January 15, 1983. The committee may report out any necessary legislation in connection with the reports.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering section 6 to be section 7.

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires rules to be promulgated in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act and requires submission of a report on interagency licensing to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional Services.

The amendment also makes certain technical changes in the language.
