STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

**AN ACT to Increase the Amount of Expenses Which May be Reimbursed to
Members of the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7033, sub-§ 3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 543, § 2, is amended to read:

3. **Expenses.** The members of the advisory council shall receive \$25 per day for their services and the council shall be allowed actual expenses not to exceed ~~\$2,500~~ \$3,500 for each fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

More meetings each year and an increase from 7 to 8 council members will require additional moneys to be budgeted for the Advisory Council.
