Amend the Amendment by striking out all of section 1
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1201, 4th ¶, last sentence, as repealed
and replaced by PL 1965, c. 226, §34, is amended to read:
Municipalities Municipality: Osborn-Plantation, No. 33
Plantation.'

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §1201, 4th ¶, last sentence, as repealed
and replaced by PL 1965, c. 226, §34, is amended to read:
Municipalities Municipality: Osborn Plantation, No. 33
Plantation.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of
section 4.

Further amend the Amendment by renumbering the sections
to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

Since the Town of Great Pond is described in the statutes
as No. 33 Plantation, this amendment removes the reference

to No. 33 Plantation from the statutes. If both sections 1 and 2 of the amendment are independently approved they will be read together.

It is the intent of this legislation that each town specified in this legislation shall be removed from the Maine Forestry District upon approval at a referendum in the town involved.
