STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require that Loads of Crushed Stone be Secure to Prevent Spillage.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1752, as amended by PL 1977, c. 32, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

No person may operate or cause to be operated upon any public way a vehicle with a load of crushed stone, unless the load is covered or otherwise secured or confined to prevent any portion of the load from falling from or spilling out of the vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that vehicles traveling on public ways with loads of crushed stone be covered, confined or secured to prevent any of the load from spilling out of the vehicle.
