STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning the Size of Exempt Lots under the Subdivision Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 4956, sub-§ 1, 2nd ¶, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 475, § 1, is amended to read:

Lots of ~~40~~ **20** or more acres shall not be counted as lots.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that lots over 20 acres are exempt under the subdivision laws. Currently lots over 40 acres are exempt.
