HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 293,
L.D. 337, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Maine State Lottery."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the last 6 underlined lines before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the following:

'3. Quorum. A quorum shall be 2 members of the council. No action may be considered unless a quorum is present and any action taken shall require a majority vote of the members present.'
