STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Law Concerning the Legitimacy of Children of Certain Marriages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

19 MRSA § 633 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently the law distinguishes between children of certain marriages. If a marriage is annulled because of the blood relation of the parties, any child is considered illegitimate. This law is archaic and should be repealed.
