COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 155, L.D. 363, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit Voter Registration on Election Day and the 7 Business Days next Prior to Election Day."

Amend the bill in section 5, 4th line after the amending clause (3rd line in LD) by striking out the following "~~2nd 5th~~ and ~~3rd 6th~~" and inserting in its place the following: '~~2nd 8th~~ and ~~3rd 9th~~'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require registrars in towns with populations of 2,500 or more to accept registrations on the 8th and 9th business days prior to election day.
