Amend the bill in that part designated "§3862." by
striking out all of the 2nd line and inserting in its place the
following:

'The purposes of the municipal energy commission may
include the following:'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862."
by striking out at the end of subsection 5 the underlined
word "and"

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862."
by striking out the period at the end of subsection 6 and
inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§3862."
by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

'7. Other purposes. To serve other purposes related to
energy as specified by the municipality.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment clarifies the permissive rather than mandatory
nature of this enabling legislation.
