COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 317, L.D. 383, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Allocations from the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Wildlife for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30,
1982 and June 30, 1983."

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the
(15 in L.D.)
last 14 lines and inserting in their place the following:

Amounting to \$8,769,677 for the fiscal year ending June 30,
1982 and \$8,866,009 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency
clause the following:

'Sec. 6. Allocation to pheasant stocking program. The
allocation to the pheasant stocking program in fiscal year 1982-83
shall not exceed the revenues raised by the sale of pheasant
stamps in fiscal year 1981-82.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

This amendment increases the central administrative services allocation \$106,843 in fiscal year 1981-82 and \$16,198 in fiscal year 1982-83.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides an additional allocation to the capital account in fiscal year 1981-82 of \$133,300 and \$14,199 in fiscal year 1982-83 which represents the following:

1. \$50,000 in fiscal year 1981-82 to construct a regional headquarters building in Gray to replace the Scarborough building which must be vacated;

2. \$41,970 in fiscal year 1981-82 and \$28,714 in fiscal year 1982-83 to replace motor vehicles which are beyond repair;

3. \$11,550 to provide new interchangeable pontoons for aircraft and 2 KT 76 transponders which are aircraft radio safety devices; and

4. \$16,366 for video equipment, a slide projector and a motor vehicle for the public information division.

It represents an increase in the All Other account of:

1. \$5,650 for publications and operation of motor vehicles in fiscal year 1981-82 and \$5,750 in fiscal year 1982-83; and

2. \$7,764 for expenses for in_state and out_state public information programs in fiscal year 1981-82 and \$8,191 in fiscal year 1982-83.

It represents a reduction of \$26,457 for one position in the real estate division in fiscal year 1981-82 and \$26,457 in fiscal year 1982-83.
