SENATE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 348, L.D. 396, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Mileage Reimbursement Payment for Jurors."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1215, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 391, §1, is amended to read:

§1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror shall be paid mileage at the rate of ~~10¢~~ 15¢ per mile for his travel expenses from his residence to the place of court holding/and return and shall be compensated at the rate of \$20 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
