COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 382, L.D. 425, Bill, "AN ACT to Further Competition with New Hampshire in the Liquor Trade."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 .

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out in the first line the underlined abbreviation figure and punctuation

"Sec. 2."

Further amend the bill in section 2 by inserting at the end before the statement of fact a new sentence to read:

'There is allocated from the Legislative ~~account~~ allowance, \$3,900 to cover daily / travel and other necessary expenses of the committee.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment strikes out the provision to establish 3 more discount liquor stores, while retaining and funding the study provided for in the bill.
