COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 382, L.D. 425, Bill, "AN
ACT to Further Competition with New Hampshire in the Liquor Trade."

Amend the bill in section 2 by inserting at the end a new
sentence to read:

'There is allocated from the Legislative ~~account~~ ^{allowance} \$3,900 to cover
daily / travel and other necessary expenses of the committee.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

Section 1 of the bill would result in unestimated costs from
setting up 3 additional stores. There would also be expected an
increase in general fund revenues through higher sales.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment funds the study and adds a fiscal note to
the bill.
