STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Membership on the Commission on Uniform State Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA § 241, first sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 771, § 15, is further amended to read:

The Commission on Uniform State Laws, as heretofore established, shall consist of ~~3~~ 4 members to be appointed for a term of 4 years by the Governor.

Sec. 2. 3 MRSA § 241, last ¶ is amended to read:

Each commissioner shall serve without compensation, but shall be entitled to receive his actual disbursements for his expenses in performing the duties of his office, **however travel expenses shall be for no more than 3 commissioners.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the membership on the Commission on Uniform State Laws and provide full and more effective participation in conference activities.
