COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 174, L.D. 454, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Continue the Joint Select Committee on Decommissioning  
of Nuclear Generating Facilities."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause  
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature  
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless  
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, loss of continuity would hamper the select  
committee in completing its business; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill in the 3rd line after the enacting  
clause (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word "Facilities"  
the words 'as reconstituted by this Act'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of  
Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in  
the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency  
clause in order to assure continuity of the study and clarifies

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the intent that the committee, originally constituted in the 109th Legislature, should be reconstituted by this legislation.
