STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Professional Service Corporation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

13 MRSA § 713, first sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 439, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The corporate name of a corporation organized under this chapter shall contain the words "chartered" or "professional association" or the abbreviation "P.A."

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to simplify the present law.
