STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require the Office of Energy Resources to make an Analysis of Sources of Fuel for the Replacement of Maine's Power Entitlement from the Maine Yankee Nuclear Power Plant.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 5005, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, sub-¶ (2), first sentence, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 388, § 1, is amended to read:

A description and quantification of the availability of various energy resources for the State, including, particularly, an analysis of replacement resources for nuclear-generated electric power, with regard to type of resource, availability and cost, which could be utilized in 5-year intervals from the date of the plan.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will emphasize the need for inclusion in the state's energy resources plan of an analysis of the availability and cost of fuel which would be necessary in the event of a shutdown of Maine Yankee in advance of its scheduled closure.

This information will be updated every 2 years as an integral part of the state's energy resource planning.
