STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning the Posting of the Agenda for Meetings of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 151, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 37, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The commissioners shall provide the same public notice of the agenda of a session as is given for any public hearing conducted by them, but in no event less than 7 days prior to the session. The commissioners may, but are not required to, have the agenda posted by a constable.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for at least 7-days public notice of the agenda of any session of the county commissioners.
