SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 188, L.D. 490, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Employment
of Minors and Overtime Pay."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before section 1
the following:

'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §738, as amended by PL 1975, c. 701,
§15, is amended to read:

§738. Penalty for employers

Any person who violates any of the provisions of
sections 701 and 702 shall be punished by a fine of not less
than ~~\$25~~ \$50 nor more than ~~\$50~~ \$100 for the first offense;
for the 2nd offense by a fine of not less than ~~\$50~~ \$100 nor
more than \$200; for a 3rd offense and for every subsequent
offense by a fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$500.'

Further amend the Amendment by renumbering sections 1 and
2 to be sections 2 and 3.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the penalties
for violation of the child labor laws.
