SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to  
S.P. 188, L.D. 490, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Employment  
of Minors and Overtime Pay."

Amend the amendment by striking out  
everything after the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its  
place the following:

'26 MRSA §738, as amended by PL 1975, c. 701, §15, is  
amended to read:

§738. Penalty for employers

Any person who violates any of the provisions of sections  
701 and 702 shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~§25~~  
§50 nor more than ~~§50~~ §100 for the first offense; for the 2nd  
offense by a fine of not less than ~~§50~~ §100 nor more than  
\$200; for a 3rd offense and for every subsequent offense by a  
fine of not less than \$250 nor more than \$500.'

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the penalties  
for violation of the child labor laws.
