COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 188, L.D. 490, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Employment of Minors and Overtime Pay."

Amend the bill in the title by striking out the words "and Overtime Pay"

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §783 is amended to read:

Penalties;
§783. Failure to perform duties in office

Whoever, being authorized to issue a work permit, knowingly fails to perform the duties of his office as required by this subchapter shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~25~~ 50 nor more than ~~50~~ 100, ^{for} each offense.

Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §784 is amended to read:

§784. Penalties; certification of false statements

Whoever, being authorized to sign the work permit, or whoever, signing any certified copy of a town clerk's record of birth, or certified copy of a child's baptismal record or a physician's certificate, knowingly certifies to any false statement therein shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~25~~ 50 nor more than ~~50~~ 100, for each offense. '

Statement of Fact

The amendment increases the penalty for failure to perform duties of office or certification of false statements regarding employment of minors.
