STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Use of Aircraft by Aircraft Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

6 MRSA § 53, sub-§ 5, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 678, § 32, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, aircraft dealers are allowed to use aircraft placed upon the market for sale, as if properly registered, up to 15 months after it is first offered for sale. This bill would remove the 15-month time restriction.
