STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

**AN ACT to Repeal the Law Preventing Hotels and Restaurants from Permitting
Secular Business on Sunday.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 3208 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This obsolete and unenforced law prevents hotels and restaurants from allowing persons, other than travelers, strangers or lodgers, to drink or idly spend their time at play on Sunday.
