Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the age require-
ment to carry a concealed weapon from 18 to 21 years/^{of age.} Under
present law a person must be 21 years of age to purchase such
weapons, ^{therefore,} the age/for carrying such weapons should not
be any less.
