STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Sales Tax on Bird Seed.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 7 is amended to read:

7. Products used in agriculture production, and bait. Sales of seed, feed, bird seed, hormones, fertilizer, pesticides, insecticides, fungicides, weed killers, defoliants, litter and medicines used in agricultural production and sales of bait to commercial fishermen.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under existing law, sales of feed for chickens or other commerical birds is exempt from the sales tax. Feed for other birds not grown commercially is taxed. This bill removes that distinction and exempts the sales tax on all seeds for all birds.
