SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 502, L.D. 553, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Workers' Compensation Cost Containmentment."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 39 MRSA §54, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 493, §1, is further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence a new sentence to read:

The maximum annual adjustment required under this section is 5%.

Sec. 2. 39 MRSA §55, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 493, §2, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The maximum annual adjustment required under this section is 5%.


Sec. 3. 39 MRSA §58, first ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 770, §217, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The maximum annual adjustment required under this section is 5%.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment implements one of the recommendations of the Blaine House Conference on Small Business.

It places a 5% cap on all annual benefit adjustments under the Act
