COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 208, L.D. 573, Bill,  
"AN ACT Authorizing Mid-State Business School to Confer  
Associate Degrees."

Amend the Bill in the 5th and 6th line (4th and 5th in L.D.)  
after the enacting clause by striking out the words "associate  
degrees of science in accounting, science in business manage-  
ment and secretarial science" and inserting in their place the  
following: 'an associate degree in applied science'.

Statement of Fact

This amendment gives Mid-State Business School the  
authority to confer an associate degree of applied science.
