HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to/S.P. 212, L.D. 577, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike for the University  
of Southern Maine."

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the  
title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1201, first sentence, is amended to read:

In order to guide the users of ← ----- → the state turnpike  
system to the exit leading therefrom to the major recreational areas  
and other areas, structures and objects of local, regional and  
statewide interest of the State, there shall be erected and main-  
tained at strategic points on the rights-of-way beside the lanes  
of traffic approaching the said exits, separate descriptive and  
directional signs of such design that each sign will be conspic-  
uous and readable when traveling at the maximum lawful speed.

Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§33 is enacted to read:

33. University of Southern Maine. Such sign shall be  
constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike at exit 8 and  
shall be worded as follows:

EXIT FOR UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MAINE'
