COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 212, L.D. 577, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike for the University of Southern Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1201, first sentence, is amended to read:

In order to guide the users of the state turnpike system to the exit leading therefrom to the major recreational areas and other areas, structures and objects of local, regional and statewide interest of the State, there shall be erected and maintained at strategic points on the rights-of-way beside the lanes of traffic approaching the ~~said~~ exits, separate descriptive and directional signs of such design that each sign will be conspicuous and readable when traveling at the maximum lawful speed.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the ^{beginning of the} /first line after the enacting clause the following: 'Sec. 2.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for inclusion of signs other than recreational signs to be constructed on the Maine Turnpike and ~~Highway~~ System.
