STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike for the University of Southern Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 32 is enacted to read:

32. University of Southern Maine. Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike at exit 8 and shall be worded as follows:

EXIT FOR UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MAINE

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes a sign on the Maine Turnpike, at exit 8, for the University of Southern Maine.
