HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 586, L.D. 601, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Exclusion of Covered Persons under a Personal Automobile Policy."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2916-B." by inserting at the end the following:

'Every endorsement under this section shall contain the following notice in conspicuous print:

"NOTICE TO POLICYHOLDER

IF THE PERSON EXCLUDED FROM COVERAGE BY THIS ENDORSEMENT IS UNDER YEARS,
THE AGE OF 18 / YOU CAN BE HELD LIABLE UNDER STATE LAW FOR HIS OR
HER NEGLIGENCE WHEN HE OR SHE OPERATES YOUR VEHICLE WITH YOUR
PERMISSION. YOUR POLICY DOES NOT INSURE YOU AGAINST THIS LIABILITY."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to warn policyholders who agree to exclude a minor from coverage that they will not be insured against any liability for that minor's negligence which might be imputed to them under state law if they were to permit that minor to continue driving their car.
