AN ACT Appropriating Funds to the Soil and Water Conservation Commission to Restore an Executive Budget Cut.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to restore \$10,000 to the State Soil and Water Conservation Commission budget which was removed by an across-the-board 8% executive cut. These funds will enable the commission to continue the present level of soil survey progress.
