SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 222, L.D. 609, Bill,

its place the following: 'Regulation'

Further amend the Bill in section 11 in that part  
designated "§4053-A." by striking out in the 2nd line from the  
end the underlined word "subject" and inserting in its place  
the ←————→ underlined word 'subject'


Further amend the Bill in section 12, subsection 1,  
by striking out in the first sentence the underlined word  
"descretion" and inserting in its place the  
underlined word 'discretion'
