COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 226, L.D. 612, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Reapportionment for Municipal Officers."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first  
line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation  
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before  
the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §5353, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Exception. This section does not apply to cities  
or towns whose charters specify different methods of  
reapportionment.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate a conflict  
between the bill and reapportionment provisions contained  
in some municipal charters.
