COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 556, L.D. 635, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend Provisions Concerning the Operation of the
Operation after Suspension and Habitual Offender Laws and
Certain Nonsentencing Provisions of the Operating under the
Influence Law."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of sections 4, 5
and 9.

Further amend the Bill in section 12, paragraph A,
all of
by striking out/the 3rd sentence and inserting in its place
the following:

'If the arresting officer determines that the arrested person has
a prior conviction, he shall cause to be issued a complaint
for a 2nd violation in accordance with subsection 10, paragraph B.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 13.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The deletions proposed in this amendment are related
to the passage of other bills. The changes proposed
by sections 4 , 5 and 13, and the 3rd sentence of paragraph
A of section 12 of this bill were made in Legislative Document
1541. The change proposed in section 9 of the bill were made
in Legislative Document 720.
