**AN ACT to Extend the Use of Red Lights to all Ambulance Service Personnel.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**29 MRSA § 1368, sub-§ 4**, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 82, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

**Members of a licensed private emergency ambulance service may display a red blinker, in the manner set out in this subsection, when written authorization is signed by the chief of that service.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove discrimination in present law against private emergency ambulance services which have a like and equal mission to save lives.
