STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Name the Bridge at Brownville Village which Crosses Pleasant River the Rodney W. Ross Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Rodney W. Ross Bridge designated. Resolved: That the bridge in Brownville Village which crosses Pleasant River be designated as the Rodney W. Ross Bridge.
