STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Law Providing Reimbursement for Travel Involved in Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 427, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 127, § 169, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision which requires that counties reimburse municipalities for costs incurred in travel involved in criminal cases. This section is not realistic, as in urban areas it would necessitate a shuttle service and in rural areas the cost would be prohibitive.
