COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 626, L.D. 709, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase Eligibility Levels for the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6108, as amended by PL 1977, c. 686, §16, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: §6108. Income limitation

No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to claimants of single member households with household income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and \$6,200 in each succeeding year for which relief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable may be granted to claimants of households of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,700 in calendar year 1980 and \$7,400 in each succeeding year for which relief is requested.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act. COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to H.P. 626, L.D. 709

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act is effective for refunds granted in 1981 for the 1980 calendar year.

Statement of Fact

This amendment increases levels of eligibility for the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Program so that persons receiving cost-of-living increases equal to Social Security increases each July 1st will not be eliminated from the program.
